- ◆ **LIFE MEMBERSHIP:** Requirements for Life membership, according to the SBE by-laws section 1(g): “Any Member or Fellow in good standing who has retired from broadcast engineering, is at least 65 years of age, and who has been a member in good standing for FIFTEEN (15) or more consecutive years immediately preceding application, may, at his request, be placed on the Life Membership list.” There is a one-time application fee of \$85, which must be included with the application.
- A Life member retains membership in the Society of Broadcast Engineers for the rest of his or her life. After the initial application and fee, there is no further cost. Life members have full benefits of membership, including discounts on SBE certification, educational programs, technical books and will receive *The Signal* and other communications from the SBE National Office. They also have voting privileges in the annual election of the national Board of Directors.
